FULL-TIME CLINICAL/COUNSELING/SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST POSITION

Xavier High School is seeking to hire a full time clinical, counseling or school psychologist to join the team of our School-Based Psychotherapy Program. The primary responsibility is to provide direct therapeutic support to students and their families in order to address students' mental health needs and improve both mental health and educational outcomes. The psychologist will also supervise psychology externs in the practice of psychotherapy.

Anticipated start date: September 2023.

Job Responsibilities

- Establish positive, trusting rapport with students and their families
- Complete intake/psychodiagnostic assessments with each student referred and create an individualized treatment plan in collaboration with students and their families
- Meet with students regularly to provide clinical services
- Conduct ongoing assessments of progress
- Conduct risk assessments and build safety plans to manage high risk behaviors across environments
- Involve and advise family members as appropriate
- Refer students to outside treatment as appropriate
- Provide individual and group therapy
- · Maintain thorough records through TherapyNotes
- Work in collaboration with Xavier's consulting psychologist, the school counselors, administration, and teachers
- Contribute to program development
- Assist with professional development of staff, parents, and community
- Possible supervision of psychology trainees



Qualifications

- Ability to build rapport quickly with adolescent boys
- Excellent time-management skills
- Training and experience in providing therapy to adolescents
- Practices from a trauma-informed perspective

- PhD or PsyD in Clinical, Counseling, or School Psychology
- NYS licensure as psychologist or license eligible
